4. Budget: To suggest products that will fit your needs as well as your budget, we need know what you plan to invest in your project.
5. Plumber information (if you have selected one)
6. Timeline:
 - * When do you plan to start project?
 - * When would you like project to be completed by?
 - * What is the current stage of your project?
